safety performance

Demonstrated excellence in safety, with low accident rates, near misses, and injuries. (Contractor Monthly WHS performance checklist)

compliance with regulations

Adherence to safety regulations and standards, ensuring up-to-date knowledge and maintaining safety protocols. (e.g., always having SWMS or JSA for jobs)

safety training

Implementation of comprehensive safety training programs to educate employees on safety procedures, hazards, and best practices.

safety culture

Fostering a culture of safety by promoting awareness, encouraging reporting of unsafe conditions, and fostering open communication about safety concerns.

Award prizes

Recipients will receive a prestigious plaque in recognition of their outstanding commitment to safety.

incident reporting & investigation

Prompt reporting, thorough investigation, and implementation of corrective actions to prevent future occurrences.
